Anything <sup>developed</sup> was going to be annexed by the City - litigation involved. Mostly going to be residential and some commercial. Specific Plan Amendment probably needed. General Plan references cemeteries. Lack thereof. Parcel is right off <sup>Camino Tassajara</sup> Tassajara Road. South of Highland Road. Parcel is 188 acres. South <sup>small</sup> parcel is 32 <sup>-acre</sup> parcel (APN 223-020-007). Not rezoned - in Sphere of Influence, outside

Specific Plan Area, area is in East Side Specific Plan - no study until 2010. It is outside urban limit line, but w/in San Ramone's sphere of influence. Not in close proximity to residential. Bordered by open space areas designated by city Cindy Yee. Owner is Sid Corrie, according to records.
