BACKGROUND:

On October 10, 2006, the County entered into a contract with Sponamore Associates (a subsidiary of PRISM LLC) to assist staff in the preparation and completion of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for a new Cemetery proposed at 7000 Camino Tassajara in the Tassajara area (County File LP052096). During the preparation of the Draft EIR and its subsequent release for public comment in September 2011, staff received a substantial amount of comments from responsible agencies and other interested parties. This contract amendment covers additional costs incurred associated with the release of the Draft EIR, and anticipated costs needed to respond to public comments received to finalize the completion of the EIR. Staff recommends that the Board approve and authorize a budget augment to increase the payment limit by \$136,322.00 to a new total payment not to exceed \$400,422.00 and extend the term of the contract from December 31, 2012 to December 31, 2013.
