Information session on Tassajara cemetery

The city will hold a public meeting Tuesday to discuss plans for the proposed Creekside Cemetery in the Tassajara Valley.

The controversial 59-acre project, which could include 100,000 to 150,000 burial plots, has been proposed by Danville developer Sid Corrie. To be built, it will require approvals from the Contra Costa County Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors.

Mayor Bill Clarkson and Vice Mayor Phil O'Loane are hosting the 7 p.m. session at City Hall, 2222 Camino Ramon, to build public awareness of the project that would be located near the Tassajara Ridge Regional Trail, about 2,300 feet from existing homes on Windemere Parkway.

City staff and representatives of the county and the proposed development also have been invited to share their updates of the project. The city will also be taking public comments.
