Ask San Ramon to oppose a cemetery that destroys rare wildlife habitat at a study session on Tuesday June 24th at 7PM at City Hall (2222 Camino Ramon).

- Tuesday June 24th at 7PM at San Ramon City Hall (2222 Camino Ramon).
- Study session about proposed 59 acre cemetery off Camino Tassajara near Windemere Pkwy that would rise from Camino Tassajara up on to Tassajara Ridge, destroy and fragment rare wildlife habitat, and degrade the Tassajara Ridge scenic trail and Hidden Valley Open Space.
- Hosted by San Ramon Mayor Bill Clarkson and Vice Mayor Phil O'Loane.
- Please come to the meeting and make comments. If you can't make it, email the San Ramon City Council and County Supervisor Candace Andersen (emails below) and tell them why the Creekside Memorial Cemetery is a bad idea.
- San Ramon is not the decision-maker on this project, the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors is.
- We want San Ramon to oppose the cemetery and help influence the Board of Supervisors.
- At the very least, the 'upper gardens' part of the cemetery should be removed to avoid fragmenting rare wildlife habitat and impacting Hidden Valley Open Space. Neighbors are very concerned about effects on water.
